Over the last twelve months the Seaview working Group have been working on the following key projects in your area.

1. **Security** – regular communication of the security incidents in the area and setting up the night time guard initiative. Plus obtaining lower monitoring costs for businesses in the area.
2. **Erosion of the Port Road river edge** – we have submitted to both the Greater Wellington Regional Council and the Hutt City Council on increasing the work priority for erosion protection along this stretch. The result has been the HCC and GWRC agreeing to install a sea wall within 12 months costing approx. \$1,200,000 to protect Seaview Businesses
3. **Events** ... Businesses participated in the STEMM festival in June to show secondary students what work in industry is like. Plus late last year Spotlight on Seaview was held.
4. **Lightwing** – SWG have been working with the E Tu Trust to build this sculpture on the main roundabout into Seaview as a form of identity and signage for our industrial area and a sculpture that will be made in Seaview.
5. **Monthly newsletters**
6. **Networking events** – SWG run six events annually
